Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

An upgrade to Harrington Park Public School is underway. The project will deliver 19 new permanent learning spaces, new staff and administrative facilities, a new covered outdoor learning area (COLA), and a new hall and library.

Progress update

Works on the new administration building (Building L) continue, with stormwater construction, internal flooring and finishes, and landscaping adjacent to the building.

New parking restrictions have been introduced on Fairfax Reserve Road to ease School kiss-and-drop by making parking spaces available at peak period. The changes creates 21x P15 minute parking spaces between the hours of 8am to 9:15am and 2:45pm to 4pm on School Days.

Bike hoops have also now been installed adjacent to Building H along Sir Warwick Fairfax Drive for up to 60 bikes.

Work on the new Building M was completed in time for Day 1 of Term 3. Building M is a new 2-storey learning building. It provides 13 new learning spaces, with audiovisual/interactive boards, 19 toilets, and new tiered seating.

The completion of Building M follows-on from the handover of the new hall (Building K) for the start of Term 1, 2022.

Works on Fairfax Reserve Road

Traffic on Fairfax Reserve Road will change at the completion of Building L to improve the flow of traffic around the new entry of the school. In preparation for the upcoming works, a temporary pedestrian connection will be provided.

The existing driveway to Building L will be transformed into a landscaped area. These works form part of the DA Conditions for the Project.

Works will take place between 7:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday to Saturday. No works will take place on Sunday or public holidays, unless notified.

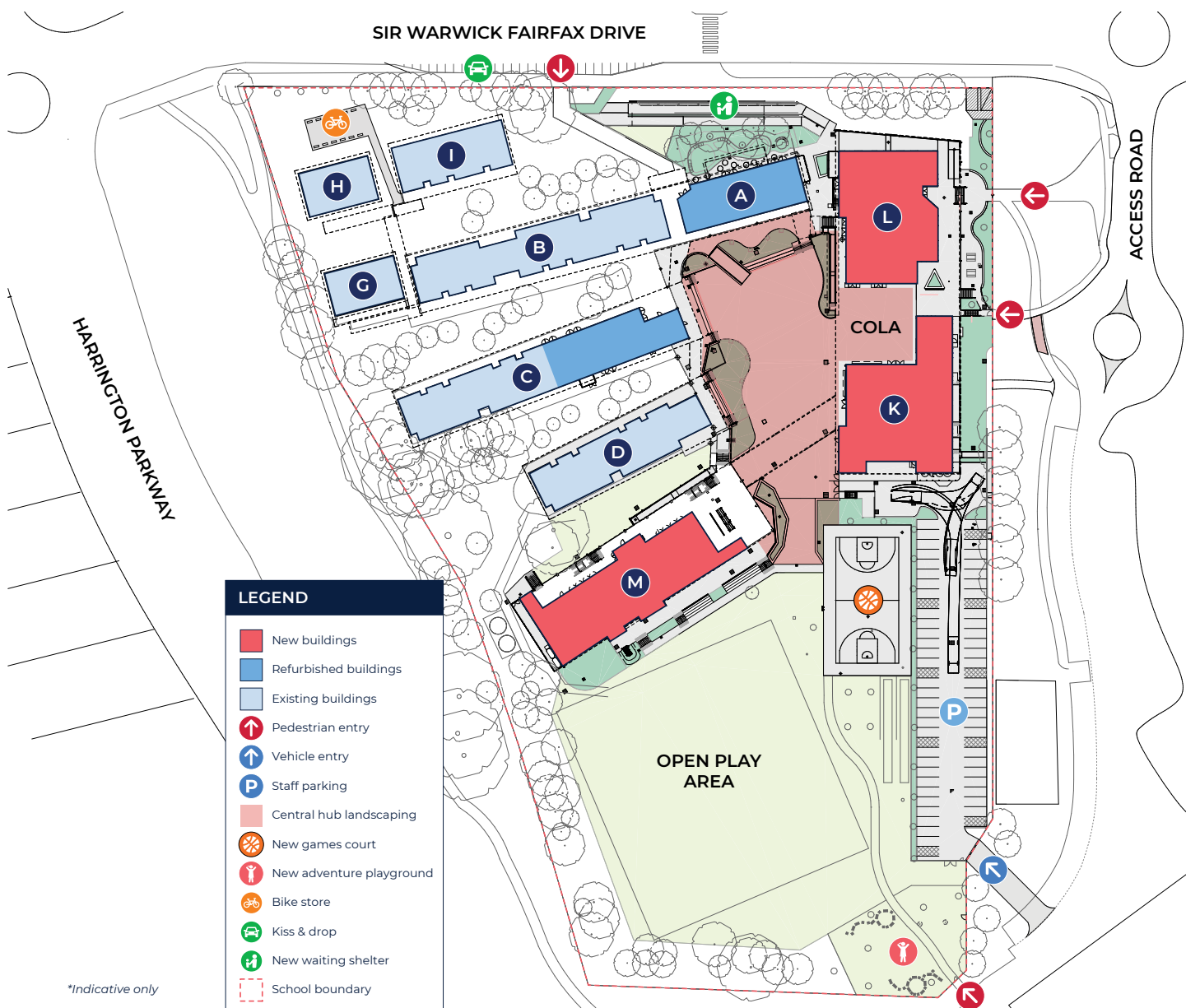
