Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

We are upgrading Hastings Secondary College to support the student community. Hastings Secondary College comprises of the Port Macquarie Campus (PMC) and Westport Campus (WPC). The upgrade will involve works at both campuses.

The Port Macquarie Campus will deliver new and upgraded learning spaces, new Technological and Applied Studies (TAS) facilities, new Creative and Performing Arts (CAPA) building, a redeveloped school entry and a new shared use multi-sports facility in partnership with Police Citizens Youth Clubs (PCYC) NSW.

The Westport Campus will deliver relocated and upgraded administration office, new flexible learning spaces and a redeveloped school entry.

Progress update

Port Macquarie Campus

- Construction works at Port Macquarie Campus are underway again, having briefly paused due to weather impacts.
- The roof of the new TAS building is now almost complete, and external brickwork is underway.
- Demolition works for Stage 2 are complete and in-ground services are being laid for both the new CAPA building and Building L upgrade.

Westport Campus

• Earthworks and preparation of external works is now underway for Building L refurbishments.

Next steps

Port Macquarie Campus

- Continue excavation and in-ground services for the new CAPA building and linking covered walkway to Building B.
- TAS courtyard hard landscaping including terraced outdoor area and bleacher seats.
- Install window frames and glazing to external facades of Building T and the new TAS Building.
- Award design and construction contract for Stage 3 of Port Macquarie Campus, the shared use multi-sports facility.
- Establish construction site and start works for Stage 3 shared use multi-sports facility.

Westport Campus

• Detailed excavation and concrete pumping for the footings and foundations of Building L.
