

Hastings Secondary College upgrade

Summer holidays works notification | 22 December 2022

We are upgrading Hastings Secondary College to support the student community. Work is underway at both Port Macquarie Campus (PMC) and Westport Campus (WPC).

Construction and maintenance will continue to take place at both campuses while the school is not attended by students or staff.

Port Macquarie Campus

From 9 January 2023, we will be removing asbestos containing materials in in Block L as part of works to finalise the refurbishment. The refurbished Block includes two new general learning spaces, the refurbishment of existing toilets, and a new staff study.

The area will be cordoned off before works start and safety measures and air monitoring put in place. It will remain out of bounds until the removal and associated maintenance work is completed.

All asbestos removal work will be undertaken in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations, the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan, and any site-specific management plans. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The area will be inspected to ensure the area has been fully remediated. The contractor will receive a clearance certificate before continuing works.

From 9 January, we will start the demolition of Building T, in preparation for works to start to reconstruct the building. For these demolition works, construction vehicles will use the Burrawan St site entrance, and all works will take place between the approved work hours of 7 am to 5 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 12 pm on Saturdays.

Westport Campus

Works are continuing the refurbishment of Block L and the creation of the new school entrance for the campus. More information about the completion of this work will be provided in January.
