Project overview

We are upgrading Hastings Secondary College to support the student community. Hastings Secondary College comprises of the Port Macquarie Campus (PMC) and Westport Campus (WPC). The upgrade will involve work at both campuses and is being staged to ensure the school remains operational during construction and to minimise disruption to learning.


Port Macquarie Campus

Stage 1 and Stage 2

Stage 1 of the upgrade at Port Macquarie Campus is construction of a new Technical and Applied Sciences (TAS) building, reconstruction of Building T and increased open landscaped areas with accessibility to areas within the campus.

Stage 2 includes the new Creative and Performing Arts (CAPA) building, refurbishment of Block L and Block B, external works and a new school entrance.

Port Macquarie Campus Stage 3

Stage 3 is a new shared use multi-sports facility in partnership with Police Citizens Youth Clubs NSW (PCYC).

It will include 2 multi-purpose sports courts, gymnastics facilities, mezzanine level with multipurpose rooms and gym and PCYC Police office, youth hub, admin, staff, and kitchen facilities.

The facility will also include the Clontarf Academy, with meeting and kitchen facilities and below ground car parking.

There will be two entrances, one within Port Macquarie Campus for staff and students and one entrance for the general public.


Westport Campus

Stage 1 and Stage 2

Stage 1 of the upgrade at Westport Campus will include refurbishment of Building L into a new administration facility at the front of the school, an upgraded school entry, covered walkways and associated landscaping works.

Stage 2 will deliver refurbishment of Building A into two general learning spaces, one shared learning area and one seminar room.




Progress summary and next steps
