Summer holidays works notification | December 2023

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to upgrade Hastings Secondary College. The Westport Campus upgrade was recently completed. Work is continuing at the Port Macquarie Campus.

Construction activities during the summer holiday period

A new demountable will be installed near the back entrance to the school, adjacent to blocks L and T.

Work will continue on the new shared use multi-sports facility in partnership with PCYC. Activities will include:

- Work to upgrade the Owen Steet footpath.
- Installation of timber sports floor.
- Internal linings, painting, joinery, and fit-out of equipment.
- Continue external cladding.
- Carpark construction and fencing.

Owen Street footpath upgrade

Works are required to upgrade the Owen Street footpath outside the PCYC facility. Construction of the footpath will start on **8 January 2024 and take approximately 3 weeks to complete** – weather permitting. Activities will include demolition of existing footpath, excavation, formwork, and concreting.

What to expect

- The footpath will be closed for the duration of the works.
- Work will be carried out in 4 separate work zones to minimise impacts to the community.
- Pedestrians will be diverted to an alternate path – see map overleaf.
- Traffic control will be in place to guide traffic and pedestrians around the work zone.
- Access to properties and driveways will be maintained.

Construction hours during the summer holiday period

The site will be closed between 22 December 2023 and 1 January 2024. Construction will restart from 2 January 2024 and take place within the approved construction hours of 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised.

The School Infrastructure NSW office will be closed from 5pm Friday 22 December 2023 to 9 am Monday 8 January 2024, inclusive.
