Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$8.8 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

We are upgrading Hastings Secondary College to support the student community. The upgrade involves work at both Port Macquarie Campus and Westport Campus. This upgrade will enhance educational delivery at both campuses, streamline and strengthen transition and pathway options for students and their community, and provide the latest modern classrooms.

Progress summary – Westport Campus

All upgrade works at Westport Campus are complete. The relocated and upgraded administration office, redeveloped school entry and new modern classrooms within Building A are in use by students and staff.

Progress summary – Port Macquarie Campus

Completed works at Port Macquarie include:

- a new Technological and Applied Studies (TAS) building
- associated landscaping, including TAS forecourt
- North South Link – accessible to all students, the new two storey walkway connects the centre of the school and provides access between Block A and Block L
- new Creative and Performing Arts (CAPA) building
- new school entry.

Remaining works include:

- rebuilding of building T into additional TAS facilities and associated landscaping works
- refurbishment of building B and building L (upgraded classrooms).



Shared sports facility update

Construction of the new multi-sport facility at the Port Macquarie Campus, in partnership with the PCYC is complete. The new facility will open during Term 2. The facility includes sports courts, gymnastics and gym facilities, multipurpose rooms, PCYC Police office, youth hub, admin and staff kitchen facilities.
