School holiday works notification | 6 April 2023

School Infrastructure NSW regularly inspects and maintains school infrastructure as part of a comprehensive and ongoing program to keep school assets in optimal condition and ensure the safety and wellbeing of our school community across more than 2,200 NSW schools.

The school holidays are the ideal time for some maintenance projects as it means work can take place without disrupting learning.

Planned maintenance

We will be undertaking maintenance and repairing potholes on Roy Watts Road during the April school holidays between 11 April to 21 April 2023 (see map below). All works on Roy Watts Road are inside the school area and signs for an alternative access to the school will be in place.



Asbestos removal works

Our contractor has identified more asbestos containing material underneath the demolished Building B and Building C (see map overleaf).

Work to remove the material will take place during the April school holidays between Tuesday 11 April and Sunday 23 April 2023. The area is cordoned off and safety measures including air monitoring continue to be in place under the advice of an independent hygienist. The area will remain out of bounds to anyone visiting the school site until the main works are finished.

Remediation works will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The area will be inspected to ensure it has been fully remediated and the contractor will receive a clearance certificate before construction continues in the area.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.

Working hours

Work will take place between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am to 5pm Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless otherwise notified.
