Hurlstone Agricultural High School

Project update | May 2023

Project overview

The NSW Government is investing in the future of Hurlstone Agricultural High School to continue its reputation of providing educational excellence to students in NSW. We are upgrading the boarding facilities and building a new farm hub at Hurlstone Agricultural High School.

The boarding facilities upgrade will deliver:

- 180 student accommodation beds
- dorm monitor rooms and amenities
- junior and senior common rooms
- overnight accommodation for rostered duty staff and 2 permanent staff residences.

The new farm hub will deliver:

- dairy shed and milking parlour, dairy processing equipment and viewing gallery
- co-located learning spaces
- calf, pig and beef sheds
- horticulture
- commodity sheds and storage facilities
- new equipment and new irrigation systems
- relocation and construction of the sheep shed, chicken pens and aquaculture facility.

Progress update

The Development Application for the Hurlstone Agricultural School upgrade has been approved by Campbelltown City Council.

Site establishment for the construction of the new boarding facilities at Hurlstone Agricultural High School was completed in late April 2023 to prevent public access to the site (see map below). The perimeter fencing near school buildings and student accommodation is made of Class A hoarding; this material was chosen for its sturdiness and height as an increased safety measure.

Main construction works are anticipated to commence June 2023.

Next steps

- Demolition of the Gate House, Dairy Cottage and two amenities blocks adjoined to Building A.
- Completion of the Farm Hub design.
- Removal of in-ground hazardous material under Building T and Building U.
