Upcoming investigation works

As part of planning for this project, we need to undertake some investigative works around the school site. These investigations will include:

- Mould investigations for Building A
- Soil investigations using small soil drills
- Ecological investigations to inspect flora and fauna
- Heritage surveys

The mould investigations and soil investigations are expected to be intermittently noisy whilst using equipment. Mitigation measures will be in place to reduce impact to students and staff during school hours.

The investigative work will take place between Tuesday 19 October 2021 and Saturday 6 November 2021.

The investigative work is scheduled to take place between 7:00am and 5:00pm within the school grounds.

There will be no work taking place on Sundays or public holidays.
