Dear staff, parents and carers,

The NSW Government is committed to delivering high potential and gifted education (HPGE) in every school by investing an additional \$50 million into the HPGE Partner School program. This is in addition to the \$50 million investment in the 2024/25 NSW Budget which has already started to benefit 13 high schools across the state.

Under the program, Galston High School will receive facility upgrades to accommodate increased enrolments, broaden educational opportunities and facilitate the delivery of tailored HPGE course offerings.

Project overview

The upgrades will include:



school entrance including the bus bay shelter, way finding, lighting and landscaping



agricultural farm and sports courts



2 textile rooms and 3 visual arts rooms



2 music rooms and performance room



2 Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) rooms and a preparation room



3 woodwork rooms and storage space, and metal work room

Planning and design work will be undertaken throughout the year.

Waddell Cottage update

Due to the heritage significance of the Waddell Cottage restoration, a further Review of Environmental Factors (REF) and consultation was required.

The tender process will start in July 2025, after which a contractor will be appointed.

The restoration work is expected to begin in Term 3.
