Dear staff, parents and carers,

The NSW Government is committed to expanding high potential and gifted education (HPGE) opportunities in NSW public schools. Part of this work is a \$50 million investment into the HPGE Partner School program.

Under the program, JJ Cahill Memorial High School will receive facility enhancements to accommodate increased enrolments, broaden educational opportunities and facilitate the delivery of tailored HPGE offerings.

Work will include:

- school entrance refresh
- upgrades to 2 science laboratories and a preparation room
- food technology classroom upgrade
- upgrades to 2 woodwork rooms and storage to support the vocational education and training (VET) program
- Science Technology Engineering Mathematics (STEM) classroom upgrade
- music room upgrade
- library and hall upgrade.

Project planning is underway and delivery of the works will be coordinated with the school.

Work is expected to begin in 2025.
