Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is committed to expanding high potential and gifted education (HPGE) opportunities in NSW public schools. This includes a multi-million dollar investment into the HPGE Partner School Program.

Under the program, 33 high schools including Koorungal High School will receive facility upgrades to accommodate increased enrolments, broaden educational opportunities and facilitate the delivery of tailored HPGE offerings.

Progress summary

Following our update in [February 2025](#), the project is progressing well.

The tender to upgrade the sports court and install a new covered outdoor learning area (COLA) has been awarded and construction will start shortly. This space is expected to be finished in early 2026, depending on site and weather conditions.

The designs for the upgrades to the library's quiet spaces, 3 science laboratories, 2 art rooms and the performing arts area are in the final stages. Construction is expected to start in 2026.
