Dear staff, parents and carers,

The NSW Government is committed to expanding high potential and gifted education (HPGE) opportunities in NSW public schools. Part of this work is a \$50 million investment into the HPGE Partner School program.

Under the program, Lake Macquarie High School will receive facility enhancements to accommodate increased enrolments, broaden educational opportunities and facilitate the delivery of tailored HPGE offerings.

Work will include:

- school entrance refresh
- food technology and hospitality classroom upgrades
- upgrades to 2 woodwork rooms and 1 design technology room including storage to
- support vocational education and training (VET) programs
- upgrades to an art room and music recording space
- new shade structure over the sports court, cricket batting nets and athletics upgrades
- provision of a marine studies laboratory and marine studies storage facility.

Project planning is underway and delivery of the works will be coordinated with the school. Work is expected to begin by the start of Term 2 2025.
