Dear staff, parents and carers,

The NSW Government is committed to delivering high potential and gifted education (HPGE) in every school by investing an additional \$50 million into the HPGE Partner School program. This is in addition to the \$50 million investment in the 2024/25 NSW Budget which has already started to benefit 13 high schools across the state.

Under the program, Narara Valley High School will receive facility upgrades to accommodate increased enrolments, broaden educational opportunities and facilitate the delivery of tailored HPGE course offerings.

Project overview

The upgrades will include:



redevelopment of the sports field and upgrades to the sport court



refurbishment of Technology and Applied Studies (TAS) classrooms, new TAS workshop and upgraded equipment in Building U



refurbishment and upgrade of the creative and performing arts (CAPA) facilities in Building U



refurbishment of one food technology classroom and upgrades to the external café area



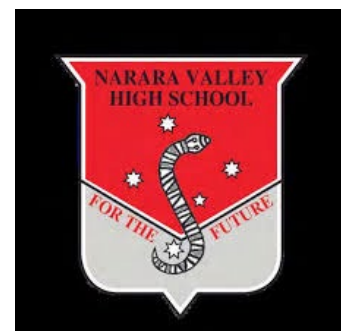
upgrades to the assembly quadrangle area



upgrades to the multipurpose learning space in Building S



upgrades to general learning spaces to support the school's Student Targeted Enrichment Program (STEP)
