Dear staff, parents and carers,

The NSW Government is committed to delivering high potential and gifted education (HPGE) in every school by investing \$50 million into the HPGE Partner School program.

Under the program, South Sydney High School will receive facility enhancements to accommodate increased enrolments, broaden educational opportunities and facilitate the delivery of tailored HPGE offerings.

Work will include:

- school entrance refresh including a new sick bay and administration area
- upgrades to 4 woodwork rooms and storage to support the vocational education and training (VET) program
- upgrades to 2 Science Technology Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) classrooms and 3 art workshops
- hall and library upgrade
- upgrade to gym laboratory.

Project planning is underway and delivery of the works will be coordinated with the school.

Work is expected to begin in 2025.
