Investing in our schools

The NSW Government's 2024-25 Budget includes a record investment in public education, with \$1.5 billion for maintenance and local upgrades to support growing communities.

As part of its commitment to high potential and gifted education (HPGE), the government is investing \$50 million in the HPGE Partner School program.

Project overview

A design consultant has now been engaged to produce detailed designs for upgrades at South Sydney High School.

Work will include:

- school entrance refresh
- upgrades to woodwork rooms and storage to support the vocational education and training (VET) program
- upgrades to Science Technology Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) classrooms and art workshops
- hall and library upgrade
- upgrade to gym laboratory.

The detailed designs are 80% complete. The tender process to appoint a construction contractor for Stage 2 is expected to be underway in August 2025.
