Dear staff, parents and carers,

The NSW Government is committed to delivering high potential and gifted education (HPGE) in every school by investing an additional \$50 million into the HPGE Partner School program. This is in addition to the \$50 million investment in the 2024/25 NSW Budget which has already started to benefit 13 high schools across the state.

Under the program, Strathfield South High School will receive facility upgrades to accommodate increased enrolments, broaden educational opportunities and facilitate the delivery of tailored HPGE course offerings.

Project overview

The upgrades will include:



Technical and Applied Studies (TAS) upgrade, including new plant and equipment, barber shop and Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) room



refurbishment of the art block including art rooms, music room and outdoor spaces



new air conditioning in several learning spaces



refurbishment of internal movement spaces with new paint, flooring and lighting



refurbishment of the Agricultural Hub



new paint, carpet and fans in several spaces throughout the school

Planning and design work will be undertaken throughout the year.
