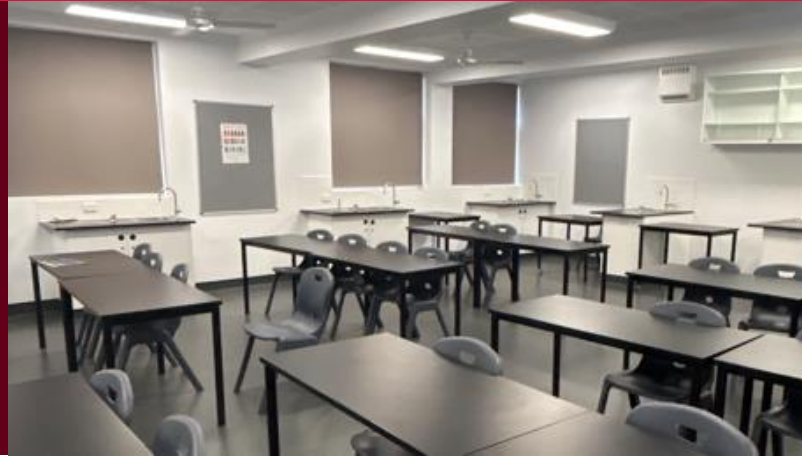

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government's 2024-25 Budget includes a record investment in public education, with \$1.5 billion for maintenance and local upgrades to support growing communities.

As part of its commitment to high potential and gifted education (HPGE), the government is investing \$50 million in the HPGE Partner School program.

Project overview

Following our update in [December 2024](#), planning has continued for upgrades at Windsor High School.

The construction contract has been awarded for Stage 1. This includes:

- minor upgrades to 3 science laboratories in Building L
- upgrades to 2 art rooms in Building M
- upgrade to food technology preparation area in Building D
- upgrade to chaplain room in Building C.

Construction for these upgrades is expected to start around the autumn holidays.

A head design consultant has been appointed, and we have started the concept design for Stage 2:

- upgrades to 2 science laboratories, three preparation rooms and a Science Technology Engineering Mathematics (STEM) classroom
- upgrades to 2 woodwork rooms, 2 metalwork rooms and storage space
- upgrades to 3 music rooms with breakout spaces
- upgrade to administration building
- upgrade to domestic food technology area
- entrance enhancement with upgrade to school street parking and improvements to kiss-and-drop traffic flow.
