Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Inner Sydney High School

A project is underway to construct the new Inner Sydney High School. The project will deliver:

- 47 innovative learning spaces
- multiple sporting and recreational spaces and shared use of Prince Alfred Park
- 5 'STEAM' focused floors including music, food technology and visual arts facilities
- rooftop garden and outdoor learning areas

Progress summary

Main construction works are underway. Tower foundation and basement works have progressed, along with internal works in the heritage buildings and services works in Prince Alfred Park.

Upcoming activities

The following construction activities will be undertaken in the month of April:

- Tower foundation and basement works, including excavation and concreting works.
- In-ground services works on the Chalmers Street footpath.
- Installation of a covered walkway on the Chalmers Street footpath.
- Landscaping works in Prince Alfred Park to reinstate turfed areas where services works took place.

Working hours

Work will take place during standard construction hours 7.00am to 6.00pm, Monday to Friday, and 7.30am to 3.30pm Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

There will be no work at the Inner Sydney High School site from Friday 19 April to Monday 22 April, and from Thursday 25 April to Saturday 27 April 2019.
