Works notification

25 February 2021

Dear Neighbour,

Inner Sydney High School is the result of the redevelopment of the Department of Education's site on the corner of Cleveland and Chalmers Streets in Surry Hills and construction of a new 14 storey high school building. The new building was open for students and teachers on Day One Term One 2021.

In early 2021 we provided notifications related to works scheduled to rectify the loop for traffic signals on Cleveland Street, and for line marking and placement of tactile indicators to areas along Chalmers Street with minor works remaining to public domain areas.

We are now writing to provide a progress update as we near our anticipated completion of the public domain works for mid-March, weather permitting.

Chalmers Street work

Work to finalise sections along the Chalmers Street footpath was requested by Council. This involves concrete pour, sandblasting, saw cutting and pressure washing and caulking to joints, followed by a general clean.

Works is anticipated to conclude by Friday 25 February weather permitting.

Hours of work

Hours of work are **10:00am to 6:00pm** in line with the road occupancy licence approved by Transport for New South Wales.

Evening work

Evening work will be required on Tuesday 9 and Wednesday 10 March, replacement of bulbs and brackets to street lights on the school side of Chalmers Street will occur. This will involve general power tools and elevated platform work.

Hours of work will be 9:00pm to 4:00am

Forecast Evening work

Pending approval from Transport for New South Wales adjustments requested by Council to the Telstra pit on the corner of Cleveland Street and Chalmers street will be undertaken. Work will involve saw cutting and the demolition of some areas of concrete to allow for the height adjustment of the pit. Work will not impact services.

Dates and times will be advised once approvals have been received.

We sincerely apologise for the inconvenience and thank you for your patience. We will endeavour to minimise impact and noise where possible.

Traffic management

Where required, traffic and pedestrian measures will be in place. Pedestrians and motorists are advised to follow all directions provided by traffic controllers and comply with signage.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.
