Works notification

The new high school in the centre of Sydney is now operational with students commencing Day One Term One 2021 in the new 14-storey tower.

The heritage buildings on the site were refurbished as part of stage one works and integrated to form a major part of the new school. Minor works remain to some public domain areas and will be completed throughout February 2021. Thank you for your support during this time.

Dear neighbour,

We are writing to provide advance notification that between **Wednesday 17 and Friday 19 February 2021** one evening of night time work will be required. An indicative timeframe of three nights has been advised in the event that adverse weather conditions extend the program. However, work is anticipated to require only one evening of work between these dates.

This activity will involve line marking and the installation of tactile indicators to areas along Chalmers Street to the intersection of Cleveland Street. Works will involve hand drilling and will require truck movements in and around the location.

School Infrastructure NSW will ensure work is considerate of neighbours, with noise kept to a minimum where possible.

Work will occur from 8:00pm to 5:00am

Traffic control will be in place as required to manage pedestrian and vehicular movements near where the work is taking place.
