Works notification

A project to bring you Stage 2 of a new high school in the centre of Sydney is nearing completion. Inner Sydney High School is the result of the redevelopment of the Department of Education's site on the corner of Cleveland and Chalmers Streets in Surry Hills and construction of a new 14 storey high school building.

One evening of rectification works on Cleveland Street in January

Dear Neighbour,

In late December we received a request from The City of Sydney Council to investigate damage to the loop for traffic lights on the corner of Cleveland and Chalmers Streets. As a result, the lights were placed on a default timer until repairs could occur.

Rectification works are now required in order to repair the lights and prevent a backup of traffic before travel volumes return to normal following the Christmas and New Year period. This will involve saw cutting to remove and replace the faulty sensor. We will make every effort to minimise noise and disruption.

We are writing to provide advanced notification that between Wednesday 20 January and Sunday 24 January one evening of night time work will be required for repairs to occur.

It is anticipated that night works will occur on Thursday 21 January, weather permitting.

Hours of Work

Work will occur from 8:00pm to 5:00am

Traffic Management

Traffic control will be in place as required to manage pedestrian and vehicular movements near the work being undertaken.
