Tower Façade Light Testing

Dear Neighbour,

We are building a new high school in the centre of Sydney. Inner Sydney High School is the result of the redevelopment of the Department of Education's site on the corner of Cleveland and Chalmers Streets in Surry Hills and construction of a new 14 storey high school building.

We are writing to inform you that as part of delivering the new school Grid Electrical will be testing the façade lighting on the Northern, Western and Eastern façade of the 14 storey tower.

We realise that recent testing caused some interruption to residents and we apologise for this inconvenience.

Façade lighting test

The project is undertaking testing of the façade lighting on **Monday 2 November 2020**. The following items will be tested:

- luminosity of lighting to East, North and West aspects
- testing of lighting programs
- testing of lighting intrusion to adjacent buildings.

We are working with local strata management to access residential rooftops to measure the lighting levels from adjacent apartment buildings.

Hours of testing

Night testing: 7:00pm to 9:00pm.

Future use of the lights

It is not anticipated that these lights will be in use nightly, but only on occasion for particular events or activity for a short period of time only.
