

Irrawang High School

Works notification | 16 December 2022

During the summer school holidays, contractors will be on site at Irrawang High School to replace the roof of the library building as part of a maintenance upgrade.

Scope

These works will be carried out over the school holidays between Monday 19 December 2022 to Friday 27 January 2023.

The scope of works within the school site include:

- installation of scaffold and roof rail to gain access to the roof
- removal of roof sheets and replacement with new sheeting
- resealing and refixing of existing downpipes.

How This Affects You

Works will commence on Monday 19 December 2022, weather permitting. All work will be carried out during standard construction hours which are Monday to Friday 7:00am to 6:00pm, and Saturday 8:00am to 1:00pm.

There will be no disruption to traffic or pedestrian travel near the school grounds, and the work area on site will be isolated within the school grounds. There will be vehicles entering and leaving the site, however there will be no obstruction of roads or footpaths for the community.

Any works involving asbestos containing material is completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. A clearance certificate will be issued at the completion of the work.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and always seek to minimise disruption and community impact at every opportunity. We have scheduled works to occur during the holiday period to mitigate disruption to school operations.
