We are pleased to announce that Hunter & Central Coast Regional Planning Panel has approved the Development Application for the project. The development consent conditions for the project are available on the NSW Planning Portal website. They can be viewed by searching the Development Applications for application number (DA 16-2023-42-1): www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au.

The project will deliver:

- new learning hub with 8 general classrooms and 6 specialist support classes
- expansion and refurbishment of the library
- new school entry
- new support student drop-off / pick-up area.

Construction activities from Monday 19 February 2024

We will now start site establishment works onsite. Initial works will include:

- Site establishment
- Installing site fencing and timber hoardings
- Site clearing
- Excavation and installing pipes and cables

Managing construction impacts

The health, safety and wellbeing of the local community is our highest priority. Construction impacts will continue to be managed in line with the Construction Environmental Management Plan (CEMP) for the project. The CEMP includes strategies such as:

- tree protection
- dust, noise and vibration controls
- stormwater, erosion and sediment controls
- traffic management.

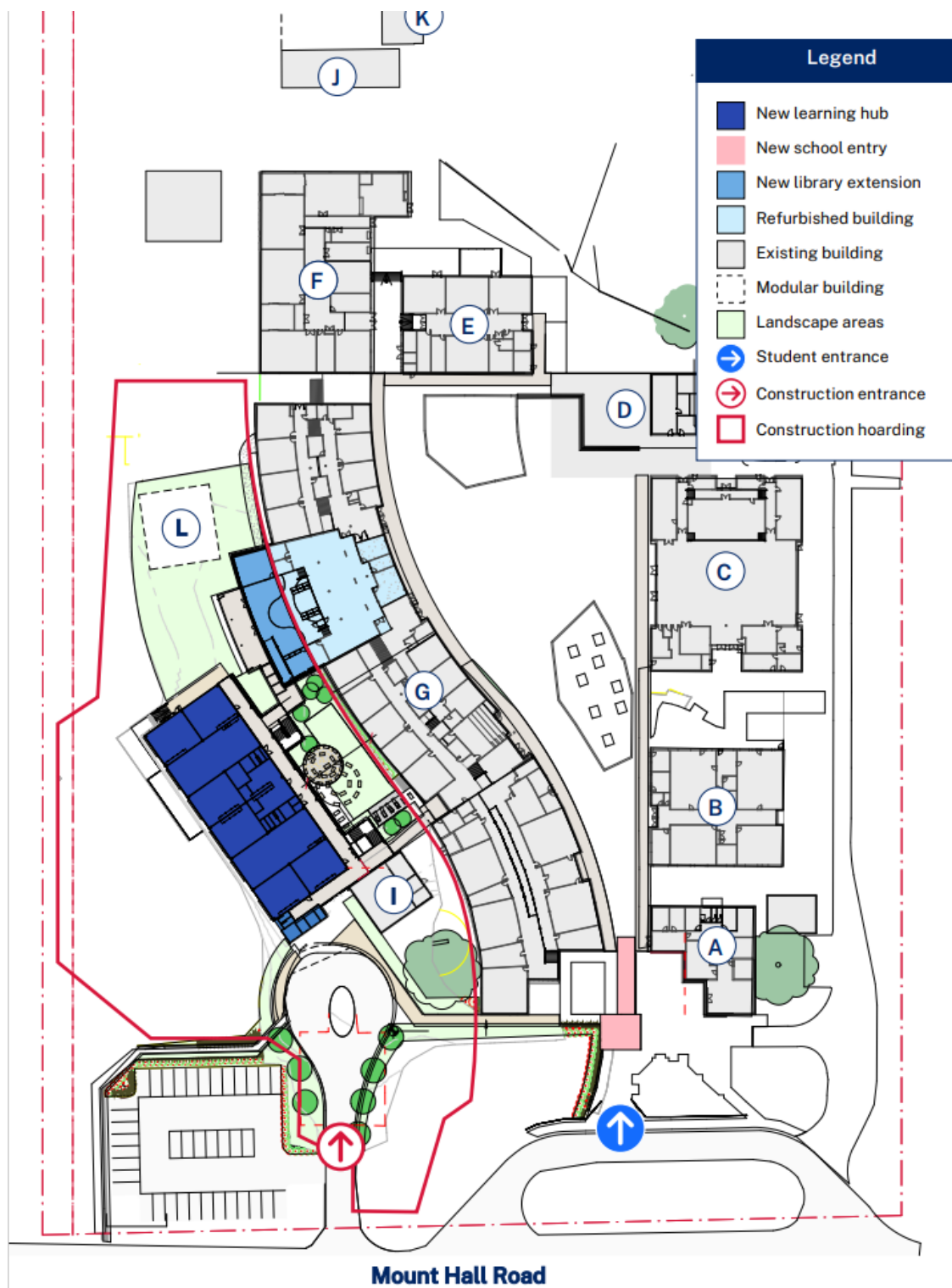
