Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

James Fallon High School upgrade

A project is underway for a new multi-purpose hall at James Fallon High School. The new hall will deliver an air-conditioned multipurpose facility for performance, sport and presentations, with capacity seating for 850 people.

Progress summary

Detailed design is complete and construction has started.

Concreting and earthworks are complete. Work will start to erect the steel frame for the multi-purpose hall over the summer school holidays.

Frequently asked questions

What works will be completed over the holidays?

Work will start to erect the steel frame for the multi-purpose hall over the summer school holidays.

What are the construction working hours?

This work will take place between 7:00am and 5:00pm, weather and site conditions permitting. The community will be kept informed of any changes to the approved working hours.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

No. There will be a shutdown period from 20 December 2019 to 5 January 2020.

What safety measures will be in place?

Health and safety is our highest priority. We will be working collaboratively with the school community and neighbours to ensure that construction works will be scheduled and managed to minimise impacts to the community where possible.

Neighbours who may be potentially impacted by construction works, including any work conducted outside of approved hours, will receive a works notification providing advance notice.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

During this time there may be some noise impacts as heavy vehicle arrive on site. All possible care will be taken to limit these impacts.

Hoarding and shade cloth has been installed to reduce dust and noise impacts on our neighbours. Dust from demolition and construction works will be hosed down with water as required. Trucks entering and leaving the site will cover their loads.

How will traffic be managed?

Construction traffic will be managed according to the traffic management plan. Heavy vehicles will be directed to use an on-site waiting area and car park.
