Frequently asked questions

What has been delivered as part of the school upgrade?

The project has delivered:

- a new school hall facility.
- indoor sports courts.
- sports and large equipment storage rooms.
- new toilets and back of house facilities.

Will there be any change to the school entrances?

There will be no changes to existing school entrances. There is an additional access gate with an accessible pathway to the hall.

When will the multi-purpose hall be ready?

Construction is now finished and the hall will be able to be used by the school from Day 1 Term 2, 2022.

What will the multi-purpose facility be used for?

The new facility offers a large indoor venue to support and extend the programs on offer at Jamison High School. The audio-visual facilities mean that workshops and student wellbeing seminars can be held in the venue as can assemblies to celebrate and recognise student achievement. In addition, the venue will be a focus for school-based sporting events and knockout competitions.

What sports can be played in the new facility?

At Jamison High School all sport and PDHPE courses are conducted on site or on neighbouring ovals. The new facility can accommodate Basketball, Netball, Badminton and Volleyball as well as a variety of indoor games that are played as part of the PDHPE curriculum. All year groups will be able to access this new facility for mandatory sport, knockout sporting competitions and the PBAL House sporting competition run during break times, promoting student leadership as well as participation. Senior Sports Coaching students will also be able to run workshops and demonstration lessons as part of their course completion requirements.
