Frequently asked questions

When will the school hall be complete?

The school hall is planned to be ready for Day One, Term One, 2022, subject to planning approval.

Where is the school hall going to be located?

The north east corner of the school, alongside Box Rd. This position allows hall access from the street frontage, while maintaining student access to amenities such as the canteen and toilets from the playground.

A number of trees are being removed, is there a landscape plan in place?

Tree removal as part of the project complies with statutory requirements.

As part of the project, a landscape design has been prepared. The plan is designed to complement the hall and surrounds.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts during construction?

Noise will be kept to a minimum as best as possible during the works. Noise levels on site will be managed in accordance with the noise control guidelines that are outlined in the EPA Environmental Noise Control Manual for construction and demolition works.

Dust from construction works will be hosed down as required.

Will there be disruption in school operations?

School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) will work closely with the school leadership to ensure continuity of school operations and to minimise any potential impact on student learning during construction.

What safety measures are in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Temporary fencing will be erected around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access. All work will be undertaken in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulation.

Can I provide feedback on the Development Application?

The Development Application will be available to view at Sutherland Shire Council. You can comment on the application by providing a submission to council while it is on public exhibition.
