Project overview

School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) is building a new school hall at Jannali East Public School. The school hall will include a canteen, sports storage, and out of school hours care (OOSHC) facilities.

Progress summary

During July 2022, the builder completed a number of works including:

- tiling and fit out of the lower ground floor
- masonry for the ground floor
- underground comms and security cabling (hall to Block N)
- roofing and installation of solar panels
- wall sheeting
- solar system installation
- substation installation and street works.

During August 2022, the contractor will work to:

- commission the substation
- fit out the ground floor
- install the building's façade, windows and door frames, ceilings and external stairs and ramp
- complete services fit out (lower ground floor and ground floor)
- start installing furniture, fittings, and equipment
- waterproof the building to ensure it is watertight.
