#### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

# Project overview

A project is underway to deliver a new school hall at Jannali East Public School. The school hall will include a canteen, sports storage, and out-of-school-hours care (OSHC) facilities.

### **Progress**

- Sutherland Shire Council has approved the Development Application (DA) for the new hall at Jannali East Public School.
- Avium, the building contractor, has installed site fences and sheds.

### Asbestos removal

In early November, we advised that asbestos containing material (ACM) had been found in a 5m x 5m area in the location of the new school hall.

This area has been cleared; however, ACM remediation works are required to continue on the remainder of the construction site.



# NSW Department of Education – School Infrastructure

We will remediate the additional ACM outside of school hours on Saturday 18 December and during the first week of school holidays, from Monday 20 December to Thursday 23 December.

There will be no further significant construction works onsite during school hours until the additional ACM remediation works have been completed and a clearance certificate issued.

#### **Next steps**

Once remediation is complete, we will begin mains works, starting with rock excavation and removal (including rock hammering) and installation of foundations and footings. There will also be regular truck movements in and out of the site during this time.

School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) will work closely with the school leadership team to ensure continuity of school operations and to minimise any potential impact on student learning during construction. SINSW will also continue to prepare notifications to neighbouring properties to keep them informed of the impact of school construction on the local area.

### Working hours

With the exception of ACM remediation works (Saturdays only), working hours are Monday to Friday, 7 am to 6 pm and Saturday, 8am to 3pm. No work will occur on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised.

All work will be within NSW Government's Public Health Orders and relevant COVID restrictions.
