Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to deliver a new school hall at Jannali East Public School. The school hall will include a canteen, sports storage, and out of school hours care (OSHC) facilities.

Progress

- The Contractor has removed contaminated soil containing bonded asbestos fragments from the site, with a clearance certificate issued in late January 2022.
- Bulk excavation has been completed and installation of building footings is underway.

Next steps

The Contractor will begin to install the formwork for the upper and lower ground slabs in mid-February 2022.

The ongoing civil and ground structure works will result in an increase in the number of trucks entering and exiting the site to maintain the supply of concrete and other building materials. Traffic control will be in place to manage truck movements. Construction traffic will be minimised during peak student pick-up and drop-off times.
