The 2023-24 Budget committed funding to progress with an expansion of Jerrabomberra High School.

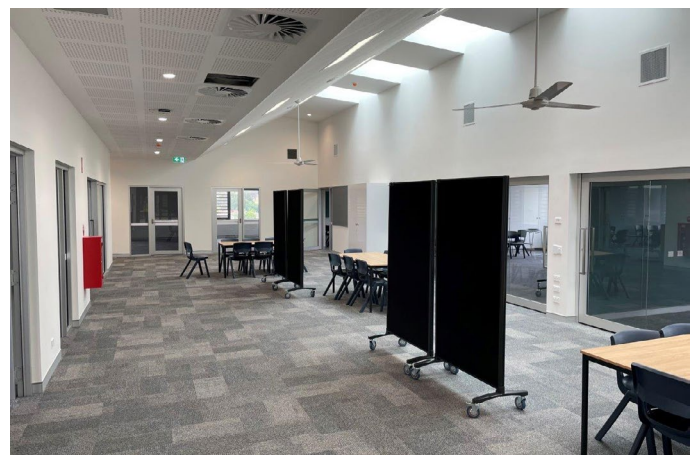
Permanent school to open Day 1 Term 1 2024

We are excited that Stage 1 of the new permanent high school will be welcoming students for Day 1 Term 1 2024. The new school will have 24 classrooms including 3 support learning spaces, to accommodate approximately 500 students.

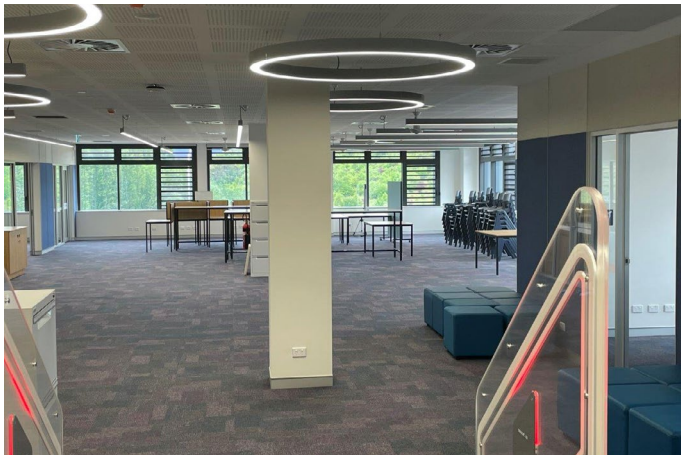

Progress update

Work on site is on track to be completed at the end of 2023. Block A is undergoing cleaning and fixing defects. Block B is undergoing minor final work and cleaning. Curtains are being installed in Block C and the sports hall. Outside, landscaping is well underway and the team is working on the special needs playground, fencing, gates and handrails.

On 8 January 2024, demolition of decks and ramps at the temporary high school starts. Removing the demountables is scheduled to start in late January.

The Stage 2 development application, which would expand the school's capacity to 1, 000 students, is now being assessed.
