Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government’s plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a historic \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to world class public education.

The 2023-24 Budget committed funding to progress with an expansion of Jerrabomberra High School.

Project overview

The permanent high school is on track to open Day 1 Term 1 2024 with 24 classrooms including 3 support learning spaces, to accommodate approximately 500 students.

Stage 2 development application update

Stage 2 expands the school’s capacity to 1,000 students with another building for 18 classrooms, a vocational education and training kitchen and a semi-commercial kitchen.

There will also be more staff facilities, new play spaces and more parking for cars and bicycles.

The Stage 2 development application with the Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council (QPRC) closed for feedback on 6 November 2023. The application is now being assessed.

Registrations for a school travel pass for Jerrabomberra High School in 2024 are now open.

The School Student Transport Scheme provides eligible students with free or subsidised travel on public transport between the boarding point closest to home and school.

We are working with Transport for NSW to understand what the bus routes to the permanent high school will be.
