

Jerrabomberra High School Project update | October 2023

Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a historic \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to world class public education.

The 2023-24 Budget committed funding to progress with an expansion of Jerrabomberra High School.

Project overview

Jerrabomberra High School opened on Day 1 Term 1 2023 in purpose built temporary facilities located at Jerrabomberra Public School. The permanent high school is on track to open Day 1 Term 1 2024 with 24 classrooms including 3 support learning spaces, to accommodate approximately 500 students.

Stage 2 development application now on exhibition

Stage 2 expands the school's capacity to 1,000 students.

It includes another building for 18 classrooms, a vocational education and training kitchen and a semi-commercial kitchen.

There will also be more staff facilities, new play spaces and more parking for cars and bicycles.

The Stage 2 development application is now on public exhibition for feedback until 6 November 2023 with the Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council.

In the sports hall the timber flooring has commenced. In the canteen, tiling and joinery is underway.

All work is progressing well on site and on track to be completed at the end of 2023.
