

Jerrabomberra High School upgrade – Stage 2

Works notification | 22 August 2024

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to upgrade Jerrabomberra High School to expand the school capacity to 1,000 students with another building for 18 classrooms, a vocational education and training (VET) kitchen and a semi-commercial kitchen.

Upcoming geotechnical investigations work

From Monday 26 August 2024, we will conduct geotechnical site investigations at Jerrabomberra High School to prepare for Stage 2 works. These investigations will involve creating a small number of boreholes across the Stage 2 site to obtain soil and rock composition information. We will use a drill rig to make these holes, which is roughly as loud as a commercial lawnmower.

This work is expected to take approximately one week to complete, weather permitting. All work areas will be cordoned off to ensure the safety of the school community.

Site investigations

Over the coming weeks, our project team and contractors, such as architects and engineers, will conduct several site visits to Jerrabomberra High School to undertake a range of site investigations as part of their planning and design work.

Working hours

Working hours will be 7 am to 5 pm Monday to Friday and 8 am to 12 pm Saturday. There will be no work on Sundays or public holidays.
