Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

Jerrabomberra High School Upgrade – Stage 2 is underway to expand the school's capacity to 1,000 students to cater for future enrolment demand in the area.

Progress update

We are now a step closer to construction with the release of the construction tender for the Stage 2 upgrade.



We are pleased to share a new artist impression of Block E which will house a new vocational education and training (VET) kitchen and 18 classrooms.

- A new shade structure to be installed in early 2025.
- Tender to be awarded in mid-2025 to the preferred contractor who will finalise the design, after which construction will start.
