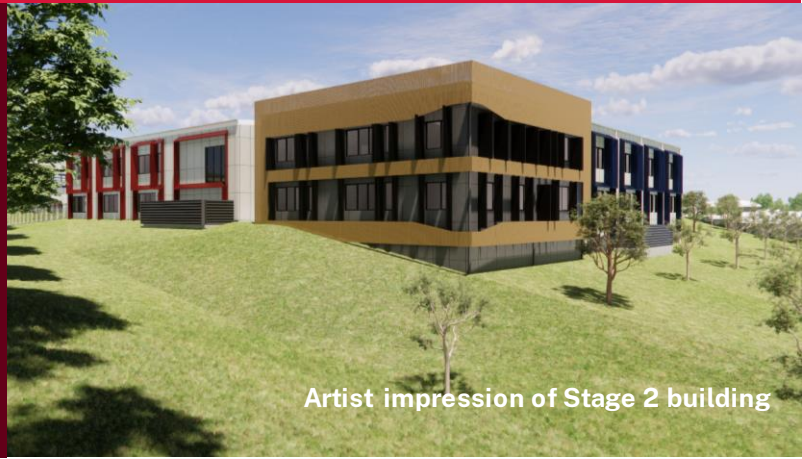


Jerrabomberra High School upgrade – Stage 2

Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

As part of this investment Jerrabomberra High School Upgrade – Stage 2 is underway to expand the school's capacity to 1,000 students to cater for future enrolment demand in the area. The upgrade will include:

- 18 classrooms
- a vocational education and training (VET) kitchen
- a semi-commercial kitchen
- staff facilities
- a new science laboratory in Building B
- a new shade structure.

Jerrabomberra High School – Stage 2 progress summary

The development application to build Stage 2 of Jerrabomberra High School has been approved by Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council. This allows the detailed design to progress with certainty that the design proposed is supported.

The new footpath at David Madew Oval to improve pedestrian and bicycle access to Jerrabomberra High School and Jerrabomberra Public School is complete. This footpath will connect the existing car park to the footpath adjacent to Palm Court.



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New playground for Jerrabomberra Public School update

In March 2024, we notified the community that we anticipated the new playground would be installed by late June 2024. Although the temporary school has been removed, the installation of the new playground was delayed. Work is now anticipated to start in Term 3 and we will keep you updated as the work progresses.
