As part of the NSW Government’s plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to build Jerrabomberra High School.

Construction of new footpath at David Madew Oval starting 25 March 2024

A new footpath around David Madew Oval is being built to improve pedestrian and bicycle access to Jerrabomberra High School and Jerrabomberra Public School. This footpath will connect the existing car park to the footpath adjacent to Palm Court.

Work will start on Monday 25 March 2024 to Friday 12 April 2024, weather and site conditions pending. The hours of work are between 7 am and 5:30 pm Monday to Friday and 7 am to 5pm on Saturdays.

We aim to minimise disruption to people using the park. The construction team will use five car parking spaces at the oval car park to store equipment and work vehicles.

Pedestrian safety measures will be in place. For your safety, please follow the direction of any temporary signage. This work is not expected to affect traffic.

Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council (QPRC) has approved this work.
