Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

As part of this investment Jerrabomberra High School Upgrade – Stage 2 is underway to expand the school's capacity to 1,000 students to cater for future enrolment demand in the area. The upgrade will include:

- 18 classrooms
- a vocational education and training (VET) kitchen
- a semi-commercial kitchen
- staff facilities
- a new science laboratory in Building B
- new shade structures.

Progress update

We are progressing the design of the Jerrabomberra High School - Stage 2 project. At this stage, we consider further input from school and other stakeholders to finalise the form of the buildings and functionality of internal spaces.

New playground for Jerrabomberra Public School update

We're excited to share that significant progress has been made on the new playground at Jerrabomberra Public School. Recently completed works include:

- installation of brand-new playground equipment and a shade structure
- laying of synthetic grass for a safe and durable play surface
- upgrades to drainage and stormwater connections
- removal of the generator enclosure and installation of a new shed
- relocation of temporary fence and concrete paths used during the temporary high school's operation.

We will be restoring the playground landscaping, including renewed planter beds and new plantings during Term 4.
