Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to build a new education campus in Jindabyne as part of the Snowy Mountains Special Activation Precinct. The purpose-built campus will include a separate primary school and high school with modern facilities to support students, teachers, and the community. In addition to new teaching and learning spaces, the primary and high schools will have new libraries, new halls, playing fields and open spaces.

The campus will also include a new Connected Learning Centre being delivered by TAFE NSW and specialist Vocational Education Training (VET) facilities for hospitality, construction, entertainment and primary industry courses.

Once completed, Jindabyne Education Campus will see staff and students accessing brand new facilities as a new primary and high school. At the conclusion of this transition, Jindabyne Central School and the existing school site will cease to operate.

Progress summary

Site establishment activities to prepare for the start of construction are underway. These works include a site survey and installation of site facilities and amenities including site safety fencing and gates. The main works contract is expected to be awarded in the coming weeks.

We have consulted with the school to confirm the concept and schematic designs and discussions are ongoing to finalise the detailed design. The detailed design will provide the level of detail required for construction.

Next steps

- Finalise the detailed design.
- Main works will get underway from mid-November 2022. The initial earthworks phase will include site clearing and excavation. This will be followed by concrete pours to install structural foundations and will involve concrete trucks and pumps. Traffic controllers will be in place where required to manage all access into the site of heavy machinery and trucks.
