

Jindabyne Education Campus

Works notification | 28 June 2024

A project is underway to build a new education campus in Jindabyne. The purpose-built campus will include a separate primary school and high school, known as Jindabyne Public School and Jindabyne High School, with modern facilities to support students, teachers, and the community.

Barry Way upgrade works commencing Monday 1 July 2024

Upgrades are being made to Barry Way to provide safe access for students, staff and vehicles traveling to, near and within the Jindabyne Education Campus. The purpose of this work is to:

- create a new intersection on the northern side of the school site
- create a roundabout on the southern side of the school site
- reduce the speed limit along Barry Way adjacent to the school from 100km/hr to 80km/hr
- include a school zone that will reduce speed to 40km/hr in school times

Works that are starting on Barry Way from 1 July 2024 include:

- Installation of environmental controls such as silk fences and drain protection
- Deploying road signage
- Tree and vegetation removal
- Roadworks surveying for in-ground facilities

Removal of trees to improve Barry Way

The upgrades to Barry Way will impact 112 trees which are located within the grass verges on both sides of the roadway. The upgrade will require the removal of 69 trees and retain 43 trees. Landscaping that will take place around the grounds of the completed project will see a number of trees planted in response to the removal of trees.

We have engaged a qualified Arborist to prepare an Arboriculture Impact Assessment, which assesses the health, condition and retention value of the subject trees and outlines stringent tree protection and removal measures required to be followed during construction.
