Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

As part of this investment a new education campus in Jindabyne opened on Day 1 Term 1 2025. The purpose-built campus includes Jindabyne Public School and Jindabyne High School. As part of NSW Government's commitment to deliver expanded access to early childhood education, this school will include a public preschool.

Progress update

Works are continuing on Barry Way to provide safe access for students, staff and vehicles traveling to and within the campus.

The following work is now complete:

- extensive in ground works to enable the location of town water supply, sewer and stormwater services to the other side of Barry Way
- regrading on Barry Way to ensure the road will be level and to assist with improvement of road quality
- temporary lighting has been installed on the southern roundabout for road user visibility.

The following work is currently in progress:

- near completion of Telstra and NBN works
- continuation of stormwater and sewer works
- continuation of road widening including kerb and asphalt works
- the final design of the permanent shared path is being finalised with council.

New public preschool

Planning for the new public preschool is underway. We are pleased to confirm that the tender for a construction contractor has been released.

The construction of the preschool is expected to be completed in time for Day 1 Term 1 2027 to accommodate up to 40 children per day and will include:

- 2 preschool rooms
- an outside play area
- administration area, amenities, staff kitchen and storage.

The new preschool will be designed to be welcoming and safe, connected with community and the environment, and an inclusive, quality play-based learning environment.

More details of the new preschool will be shared in Term 4 2025.

Continuing school traffic arrangements

Temporary traffic arrangements will remain in place during Term 4, including the presence of traffic supervisors during school drop off and pick up times.

The temporary pedestrian pathway will remain in place until a permanent footpath is completed.

Motorists are reminded that traffic control and reduced speed limits of 40 km/h are in place during the construction works on Barry Way to ensure the safety of workers and motorists.

Contraflow arrangements will be in place where required to facilitate the construction of the new road surface.
