Works notification

Stage 2 of a project is underway which will upgrade Jordan Springs Public School, and will include additional fit-for-purposes learning spaces to support the growing population in the North West Growth Area.

Stage 1 of the upgrade to Jordan Springs Public School was completed in 2020.

Vehicle access movements on 27 April 2022

As part of these works on Wednesday 27 April 2022 from 7 am to 4 pm, large concrete trucks will be accessing the work site from Lakeside Parade. Deliveries will occur approximately every 10 minutes during this time period.

- Traffic controllers will be in place on Lakeside Drive, near Crimson Street and Landsborough Street. A traffic controller will also be in place to assist pedestrians.
- Access to residential properties will be maintained under traffic control.
- For the safety of students, the local community and workers, road users are advised to obey directions and allow extra time for travel.
- Deliveries will be scheduled outside of peak pick up and drop off times, where possible.

The traffic management is required to facilitate the pouring of the concrete slab, weather and site conditions permitting. We will provide further notification if the work and traffic management need to be rescheduled.

Working hours

Traffic control will be in place from 7 am on Wednesday 27 April 2022, with concrete pour work to take place from 7 am to 4 pm. Standard project working hours are 7 am to 5 pm, Monday to Friday and 8 am to 1 pm Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.
