Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

New primary school for Jordan Springs

A project is underway to provide a new public school for Jordan Springs. The project will include:

- innovative learning spaces
- a library and a hall
- modern core facilities such as staff and administration areas
- a covered outdoor learning area (COLA)

The school will be designed to allow future expansion of up to 1,000 students.

Progress summary

The construction contract has been awarded and site establishment will begin shortly.

Site establishment starts mid February

Site establishment prepares the construction area so that construction work can begin. As part of the site establishment, we will:

- install the site office and work sheds
- deliver equipment

These works will take place between 7am and 5pm, Monday – Friday and 8am – 1pm on Saturdays.

Site signage is in place and hoarding put up to minimise noise and ensure the safety of the local community.
