# New primary school for Jordan Springs Project update May 2019

## Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

### **New primary school for Jordan Springs**

A project is underway to provide a new public school for Jordan Springs. The project will include:

- innovative learning spaces
- a library and a hall
- modern core facilities such as staff and administration areas
- a covered outdoor learning area (COLA)

### **Progress summary**

Site establishment has been completed and the Development Application (DA) has been approved by Penrith Council for early works. The next stage of work will begin in the coming weeks.

### Early works to begin

Early works including bulk earthworks will begin in early June.

Work will take place between 7am and 6pm, Monday – Friday and 7:30am – 3:30pm on Saturdays.

Site signage is in place and shade cloth installed to minimise dust and ensure the safety of the local community.

We will continue to work with the contractor, Richard Crookes Constructions, to ensure any disruption to our neighbours is kept to a minimum.
