(b) Schedule 2 Part C – During Construction, condition C40 is inserted using **bold and underlined** words/numbers as follows:

Operational Readiness Work

- C40. Operational readiness work must only be undertaken in accordance with the following requirements:
 - (a) the area(s) of the site to be used for operational readiness work are clearly and securely separated from the areas of the site still under construction;
 - (b) <u>the Applicant has implemented appropriate arrangements to ensure the safety of school</u> <u>staff on the site:</u>
 - (c) the staff car park has been made available for use by school staff undertaking operational readiness work; and
 - (d) no students or parents are permitted on the site.
