### Project update

#### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is spending \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

#### Karabar High School

A project is underway to upgrade Karabar High School. The project will deliver eight new teaching and learning spaces, one new seminar space, a new staff study facility, new covered walkways and ramps and landscape and accessibility improvement works.

#### Progress summary

The tender process for the construction contractor is now complete, and the works have been awarded to Joss Construction.

Construction will commence soon following completion of an Aboriginal archeology investigation.

As part of preparation for construction, demountables will be removed.

The upgrade is expected to be completed in mid-2020.
