Upcoming works - Karabar High School

The upgrade to Karabar High School is progressing well. The project will deliver eight new permanent learning spaces, one new seminar space, new staff study facilities, new covered walkways and ramps and landscape and accessibility improvement works.

We are writing to inform you of upcoming works on site. Over the next few weeks, concrete pours of the foundations for the new building will commence, followed by formwork, steel fixing and concreting the ground floor slab. There will be additional concrete trucks on site, as well as noise generated, between the hours of 7am and 5pm, Monday to Friday, and 7am to 1pm on Saturday. The trucks will enter the site off Alanbar Road.

Over the Term 3 school holidays, electrical works within the admin building and installation of electrical mains to the school's switchboard room will be completed.

Safety of students and the school community

Safety of students and the school community is of the highest priority to the project. The construction site is fenced and signed, with physical and visual separation of the construction area from the school grounds. Please be reminded that students and staff are prohibited from entering the construction site.

Commencement of early works at the Queanbeyan SSP site

Over the Term 3 school holidays, there will be consultants doing early investigations at the Queanbeyan School for Specific Purposes (SSP) site, which is adjacent to Karabar High School. It is anticipated that construction activity will commence on this site later this year, and we will keep you updated.
