Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$847 million is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Kent Road Public School upgrade

A project is underway to upgrade Kent Road Public School.

The project will enable the school to accommodate more than 900 students in permanent facilities by providing:

- 34 permanent, future-focused teaching spaces
- new administration and staff facilities
- a new canteen
- an extension of the existing hall to increase capacity
- a new library where the existing administration block is currently located
- more functional, increased open outdoor play space.

Progress summary

Construction of the temporary school has commenced and is scheduled for completion in early 2019. The construction contract for the main school upgrade will be awarded in early 2019.

Summer school holiday works

Over the summer holidays, the temporary school and associated support facilities will be installed. Concrete walking paths will be constructed and existing school furniture will be relocated to the temporary school.

There will be no demolition work taking place over the summer holidays.

Construction work will take place Monday to Friday, 7am to 5pm and Saturdays, 8am to 1pm. No work will take place on Sundays or Public Holidays.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.

In Term 1, 2019, access to the temporary school will continue to be from Kent Road and the existing kiss and drop area will not change.
