Works notification

Removal of asbestos containing material at Kent Road Public School

Tests have confirmed that some material found at the Kent Road Public School upgrade site contains bonded Asbestos (Asbestos that is not air borne).

Asbestos is managed in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and Safe Work NSW by licensed and accredited asbestos removalists and occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines. Appropriate safety measures will be implemented prior to removal.

A remediation plan has been developed and removal of the asbestos containing material is planned to start from Saturday 9 March 2019. The work is anticipated to be completed by the Saturday 16 March 2019.

Asbestos containing material will be removed outside of school hours, with work only taking place on weekends.

The health, safety and well-being of students, staff and neighbours is our highest priority. Air monitoring and site fencing will remain in place until further notice and we will continue to keep the community updated as more information becomes available.

The removal of asbestos containing material will not pose a risk to the local community.

The Site is now under construction and demolition will begin from Saturday 9 March 2019.
